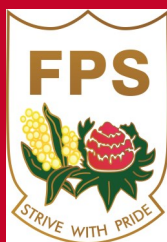

Principal's Message

We have come to Week 8 of 2016! It's hard to realise we only have 3 weeks left of school and there is still plenty packed into our final weeks. Today our K-2's are off to Hunter Valley Zoo. I'm sure they will have a great day, learning about all the animals. Wednesday 30th Nov 9.00am -10.00am we have 'Fassi Flyers' and also our Parent Café addressing issues and information on Asthma. On Thursday 1st November our staff will observe expert presentation of Explicit Direct Instruction with a focus on Writing and Friday will see our prospective Captains speeches for 2017.

PBL - Our focus for Week 8 is 'Line Up Correctly'. All our students do this well and it is these behaviours that are noticed by teachers and others when our students are out in the general public eg. Swimming, Excursions, etc. Our PBL Awards Day is scheduled for Friday 16th December and I am pleased to announce that we are only one student short of 100% attendance!

Parent Café - Our next Parent Café is scheduled for Wednesday 30th November. We have invited Sue Wells from Asthma Foundation NSW to present to our parents. This session will run from 9.00am - 10.00am and will provide up to date information about Asthma, including management and Asthma plans. Parents of children identified as asthmatics have been forwarded special invitations but all parents are welcome.

The Music Bus -We have recently been approached by a company that is trying to support music programs on this side of Lake Macquarie. The program is quite unique and as we are a small school our parent introduction session will be held in combination with other small schools at Biriban P.S on Tuesday 6th December from 8.30am - 9.00am. Our students will get to visit the bus on site during Tuesday 6th. Some information about the program includes:

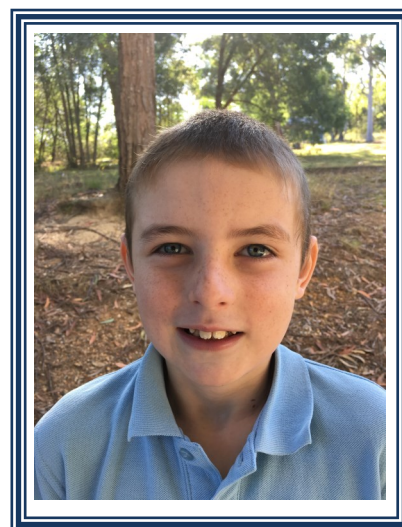
End of year party
