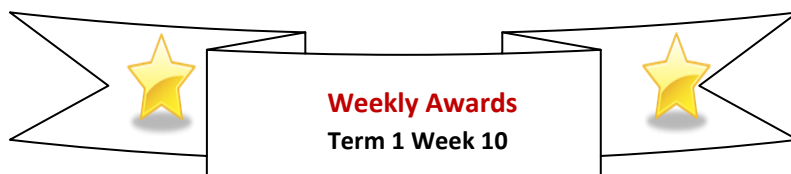


Superstar Student: Jorja Hilditch
