These little people and their families will also need to observe our restrictions and do a gate drop off and pick up each Friday.

In my last newsletter I touched on the dangers of social media on our young people. I'm distressed to learn that the inappropriate conversations, accusations and general bullying is continuing across our student email platform. Students and their families need to be aware that the Department of Education constantly audits its digital media. It is the responsibility of a team of technicians to monitor and observe the "traffic" within the email system, for staff and students. Students (and staff) who use the email platform for inappropriate conversation and threats will be identified and required to account for their behaviour. Families will be required to undertake a protocol meeting with those responsible for safe use of the Department's media. This breach of the Department's technology use agreement is serious; use of the Department's technology is a privilege.

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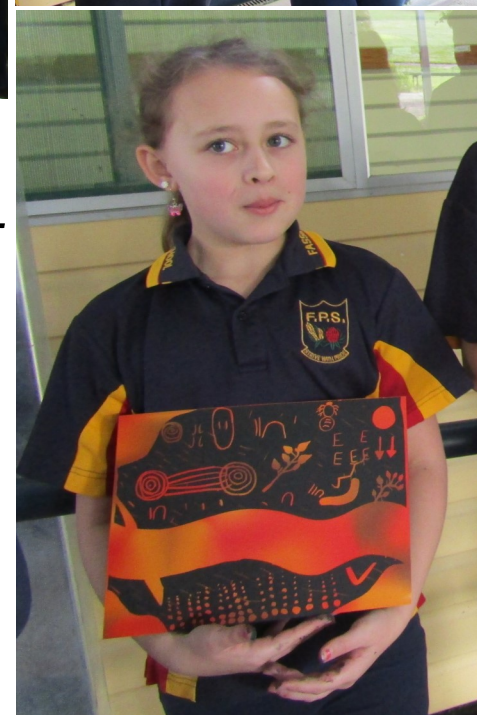


